While it's easy to explain the need to conserve potable water and reduce wastewater discharges to the environment, the environmental damage caused by urban stormwater runoff, and the broader benefits of retaining and using stormwater are not as widely understood.

Understanding the underlying science of stormwater management and being able to articulate the environmental and social impacts of current practice and the benefits of alternative management approaches is therefore important for anyone involved in promoting, designing or delivering stormwater related initiatives.

The presenters will discuss the 'point of no return' for waterways and the Bay. They will also canvass the minimum amount of stormwater capture, infiltration and/or evaporation required to maintain the ecological condition of downstream waterways and water bodies. In addition, they will present solutions and discuss why scale is important.
